• In January we appealed to your generosity to help the displaced populations living in precarious conditions. About 113,300 people were and are still in this situation.

#### **Emergency Winter January**

- Following the humanitarian disaster that has unfolded and is still unfolding before our eyes, many people suffer from lack of water and suffer from hunger ...
- We distributed more than 2,000 meals and 4,000 packages of breads.



#### **Emergency Ghouta February**

- Rime underwent her last reconstructive surgery in March. Swiss-Group was there.
- We met with the doctors and discussed about the follow-up.
- Laser treatment and lip surgery are planned soon. We have raised the money needed for the next care.
- Rime has caught up in school, she is still home-schooled. Swiss-Group pays for her education.
- Rime has moved again for a safer accommodation.

Her brothers and sisters are doing very well.

- Swiss-Group supports sick or burned orphans by a continued long term funding.
- We took care of two children with Epidermolysis Bullosa last February: Naïma 3 years old and her brother 18 months old.
- This autoimmune disease is difficult to relieve. Constant care and hygiene are essential. The costs are high because of the nursing home care, drugs.
- Thanks to a sponsor and other donors, we can arrange for a nurse to come home twice a week.
- Naïma did not walk, but since a month she is frolicking in the park.
- Swiss-Group has decided to assume all costs.
